By contrast, he referred to Spanish America as having been subject to the "triple yoke of ignorance, tyranny, and vice". As a way of keeping his mind off of his grief, Bolivar decided to return to Europe to immerse himself in the intellectual and political world he had found so stimulating.

Bolivar was put in charge of the most important republican port, Puerto Cabel. Digging deeper reveals a less rosy picture of the renowned Latin American leader. Further victories at the Battle of Carabobo, in and Battle of Pichincha, in consolidated his rule over Venezuela and Ecuador respectively. Yet today outside of Latin America, where he is still practically worshipped, his name is almost unknown.
